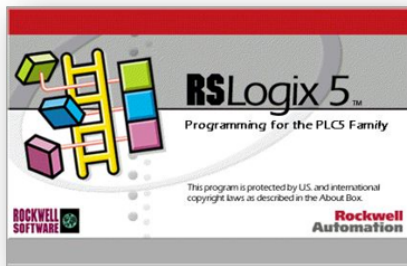

On December 31, 2025, RSLogix™ 5 has been **discontinued and no longer available for sale**. This change follows **eight years** after the Allen-Bradley® PLC-5® control platform from Rockwell Automation was officially discontinued (2017) and is also no longer available for sale.

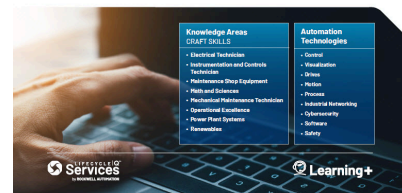
